

Instructions on How to Log In to Virtual Masters Day the first time

Welcome to TKGA's first Virtual Masters Day. This video will help you log in and get set up for a great event. You can join from the Brella website or from its mobile app.

- If you are on a computer or laptop, go to next.brella.io to sign in. (Chrome is the recommended browser but it should work in the browser of your choice).
- Click "Sign In" on the top right corner of this web site. You will see different ways to sign in.
- NOTE – when you sign in, it will ask you for your company. If you are a teacher, designer, yarn shop owner, etc. please feel free to use this space to let us know about your knitting business. If not, you can make something up or use TKGA. It is also going to ask for your job title – you can have some fun with this – Knitting Goddess, Worlds Best Grandma, Knitting Addict, Cranky without Coffee, or just put in NA. The key here is to not stress on this. The platform makes us do it, but we won't be checking to see if you really are the Fastest Knitter ever. (Please avoid politics or anything offensive.)
- If you sign in with Google, LinkedIn, or Facebook, it will fill in your email, name, and photo and you have to fill in company and job title.
- Or you can sign in with Brella. If this is your first event on Brella, you will create an account and a password.
- After creating your account, you create your profile and join the event. To join our event, you have a JOIN CODE. This is unique to you and should not be shared. If you do not have your join code by April 9, please let us know at info@tkga.org.

You can also attend our event on a mobile device.

- Download the Brella app from the [App Store](#) or [Google Play](#) and sign in using your Brella account or [create one](#). (Note it is Brella.io)
- Add your Join Code and start your profile.
- If you already created your account on a computer, you can use the password you created there to be able to access the event from your mobile phone or tablet as well as from your computer.
